

LUDLOW SIDE HILL CRONCHERS MEETING MINUTES

The 3/20/10 meeting of the Ludlow Side Hill Cronchers Snowmobile Club was called to order by President Murphy at 6:45 PM with 8 members present. The meeting was held at Brett Sanderson's.

- North Hill Cross Road re-route to remove trail from road (Angie Benson will talk to the **Gomes** family about permission to use their property for this project)

Groomer:

President Murphy has obtained quotations from Tucker and Piston Bully for a new groomer. The good and bad points of each unit were reviewed. This item will be on next months agenda for a vote to pursue the purchase of a new groomer. Application must be made to VAST for a grant by June 1st.

Brett Sanderson has scheduled a work party for Thursday, March 25th at 6:00 PM at his garage to work on the groomer. It will be prepared for summer storage or trading in depending on the vote in April.

President Murphy gave a report on recent activities of the Windsor County Snowmobile Club.
